**Haws:** The Hydration Station is a joint venture with Britta Water. Innovation water purifier to fill water bottles in the work place removes chlorine, odors, sediment from public municipal water. Interesting statistics 40% of adults consider themselves hydrants. Bottle water costs 240 -10,000 times the actual cost of the water itself.

**Chicago Faucets:** Build a faucet line, if you understand the numbering system it is very simple to order your product you can mix and match to fit your needs. First set of numbers is the body, next is the spout, then the aerator followed by the handles and then the finish. Cartridges have not changed since 1913 and you can retro the quad turn to ceramic disc. New electronic models with internal temperature adjustment without having to remove body can change from AC to DC without turning off water.

**Mansfield:** Has been around since 1929. Has a product line of the dual flush toilets and soon will have available a new 1.28 GPM toilet to comply with possible 2012 code.
