The health department is scared of a disease breakout because of using reclaimed and grey water systems, it would take much to have a disaster

The new rules are open for comment until July, after 3 years these rules will be implemented in three years (2021)

Arece Hampton – Seattle Public Utilities

SPU is required to make a conservation plan

Our water has come from Cedar river for 150 years via the Toit water shed, it has a 150 mile radius around the facility

There are no new water supplies we must conserve

Seattle's population has tripled since 2010, 1268 people a week are moving here, the water sources are strained

Current projection shows we have water until 2060 at current levels

Climate change is driving more people to the Puget Sound area

SPU is looking at all water usages and developing ways to conserve from new toilets to cooling tower adjustments
